Failure to obey the ordinance will subject the offender with a fine.

Dear Resident/Business Owner,

This letter is being sent to all residents and business owners who have sidewalks in Kennedy Township. The letter is to inform all of Ordinance #489, enacted June 11, 2013. The Ordinance addresses hazards, mainly snow and/or ice on sidewalks accessible to the public. I am certain we can all agree of the safety issues that arise when people walking are forced to walk into the street to avoid snow/ice covered sidewalks.

With this in mind, the ordinance was created for the safety of everyone using our sidewalks. Section 1 states in part, "It shall be the duty of the owner, occupant or other entity in charge of any property, whether occupied or vacant, in the Township, which is adjacent to and/or includes any form of public sidewalk, to remove or cause to be removed snow or ice from the entire width of such sidewalk". Section 2 provides 24 hours for the hazard to be removed if the accumulation is less than 6 inches and 36 hours for the hazard to be removed if more than 6 inches. Section 5 states that no person shall place or cause to place any snow upon the streets within the Township.
