## **I-376 Parkway West Improvement Project Begins Monday Night in Allegheny County**

**Pittsburgh, PA** – PennDOT District 11 is announcing the I-376 (Parkway West) Improvement Project in Robinson and Collier townships, Allegheny County, will begin Monday night, July 29 weather permitting.

Beginning at 9 p.m. Monday night, crews from Lindy Paving, Inc. will begin the \$4.83 million I-376 project located between the Route 60 (Steubenville Pike) interchange (Exit 60) and Boyce Road near the Campbells Run Road (Exit 62) interchange. Work will occur through mid-November according to the following schedule:

- Overnight single-lane restrictions will occur in both directions weeknights from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.
- Daylight shoulder restrictions will occur weekdays from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. and 6 p.m. to 9 p.m.
- Weekend work will occur from 9 p.m. to 9 a.m. in the eastbound direction and 8 p.m. to 7 a.m. in the westbound direction.

In addition to the off-peak single-lane restrictions, motorists should expect ramp closures and long-term shoulder closures.

The project includes milling and resurfacing, concrete pavement preservation, guide rail updates, drainage improvements, sign and pavement marking installation, and other miscellaneous construction activities.
